In response to the unfolding humanitarian crisis, this report presents a comprehensive assessment of the General Hospital in Laascaanod and the surrounding communities, shedding light on their critical needs and proposing urgent solutions.

1.2 Purpose of the Report

2. KEY HIGHLIGHTS

Key objectives included understanding the extent of medical supply shortages, assessing infrastructure damage, evaluating psychological trauma among staff, examining the state of education, and identifying environmental hazards.
